Finally, the student would be able to take the didactic training and apply it to the clinical training in the third semester. **An individual enrolled in this plan would be taking all the courses they are eligible for each semester to be successful in the program.**
- Both PHAR 1000 and PHAR 1070 are hybrid courses, which mean the courses are split between online and on-ground class meetings.
- Note PHAR 1070 is offered during the summer, fall, and spring semesters. It can be taken any semester the student chooses.
- *Students wishing to start in Spring Semester are only eligible to take PHAR 1000 and PHAR 1070. This student will then fall into the summer entry group following the advised plan. Other tracking options may be available.**

Accelerated fall entry would be recommended to students who would have had college level courses previously or have been in school recently, prior to entering the program. An individual taking this tracking plan should be someone who already has a strong foundation in their math, reading, and study skills. Typically students with deficiencies in math, reading, and study skills are not successful on the accelerated tracking plan.

- ☐ Prerequisites for clinical practice: PHAR 1000, 1010/11, 1020/21, 1030, 1050, and 1060/61 with a grade of a C or better. **Only PHAR 1070 can be taken concurrently with clinical practice courses (PHAR 2055, 2080).** During clinical practice the student interns in two different pharmacy practice sites for a total of 270 contact hours.
- ☐ Both PHAR 1000 and PHAR 1070 are hybrid courses, which mean the courses are split between online and on-ground class meetings.
- ☐ Please note PHAR 1070 is offered during the summer, fall, and spring semesters. It can be taken any semester the student chooses.
