1. Basic Narcotics and Lab Investigations	19-330	March 25-29	Knoxville, TN	J. Quick
This course is designed to familiarize students with basic narcotics. The course will cover the basics of drug identification as well as their uses and effects. The course will include many aspects of narcotics investigation giving the students a wide exposure to varied investigative techniques. (Specialized Law Enforcement only). (CSA Included)				
2. School Resource Officer	19-413	March 25-29	Claiborne, TN	A. Fontes
This course is designed to train the officers assigned to work as the School Resource Officer, to include safety issues and procedures that impact their daily routines. (Specialized Law Enforcement Only) (CSA, MI, EVOC)				
3. Search Warrants and Affidavits	19-332	April 8-10	Greeneville	C. Evans
The purpose of this course is to provide a review of search and seizure laws under the fourth amendment of the Constitution. This block of instruction will refresh attendee's knowledge and skills in the writing of search warrants, affidavits, probable cause requirements, search and seizure case law, the use of informants, and procedures for the execution of warrants. (Specialized Law Enforcement only)				
4. Ethics in Law Enforcement	19-322	Aug 12-16	Sevierville	Chief Myers
This course is design to prepare the officers to deal with issues concerning Ethical behavior on and off duty (Specialized Law Enforcement only)				
5. Emergency Vehicle Operation Instructor	19-321	April 22-26	WSCC Morristown	N. Antrican
(Limit 12) This course is designed to prepare the officer to instructor Defensive and Tactical Driving at the Basic Recruit or In-Service level. The course provides an overview of all subjects included in the Defensive and Tactical Driving curriculum with emphasis on the role of the instructor, both in the classroom and on the driving track. (Specialized Law Enforcement Only) (Students must drive a vehicle issued from their department for use in the class)				
6. Firearms Instructor	19-606	April 29- May 3	Sullivan County Sheriff's Office	Frazier
This course is designed to develop departmental firearms instructors responsible for departmental training and P.O.S.T. certification procedures. Topics covered will include but not be limited to: the fundamentals of marksmanship, firearms safety, moving and shooting, and care of weapons. <u>Instructor development is a Prerequisite (Specialized Law Enforcement Only. LIMIT:15)</u>				
7. Criminal Investigations	19-285	May 20-22	Greeneville Campus	Strickler
This course is designed to prepare officers to successfully complete all types of criminal investigations. Basic criminal investigations techniques will be covered including the eventual prosecution of the case. (Specialized Law Enforcement Only)				
8. Instructor Development	19-507	June 3-7	Greeneville, TN	B. Dooley
This 40-hour block of instruction is divided into a two-part curriculum. Part one covers POST rules, the documentation required for compliance with POST rules, and the legal liabilities associated with training. Part two covers Instructor Development, preparation of lesson plans, classroom presentations, and the use of Microsoft PowerPoint in the classroom. (CSA included)				

9. Basic Criminal Investigation 19-323 June 10-14 Knoxville J. Quick

This course is designed to familiarize students with types and methods of modern investigations. The course will cover the basics of an investigation, such as evidence handling and interview/interrogation. The course will cover many of the traits more specific to various types of crimes that the students will encounter during the course of their jobs. Several hands-on/interactive assignments will aid in the students' learning. (Specialized Law Enforcement only) **(CSA included)**

10. No Shots Fired 3 Day Israeli Tactical 19-325 July 22-24 Kinstlich

This course is designed to teach main Israeli tactics in dealing with crime and terrorism

**11. Officer Survival 19-324 July 22-26 Pigeon Forge Mashburn
(Limit 20)**

THIS COURSE IS TO FAMILIARIZE OFFICERS WITH TACTICS TO RESPOND TO HIGH RISK SITUATIONS ALONE OR WITH A PARTNER. (Specialized Law Enforcement only)

12. Criminal Investigations 19-285 August 12-16 Sullivan County Sheriff's Office Strickler

This course is designed to prepare officers to successfully complete all types of criminal investigations. Basic criminal investigations techniques will be covered including the eventual prosecution of the case. (Specialized Law Enforcement Only)

13. Excellence in Training 19-590 August 26-30 Willis

The Excellence in Training Course is an advanced professional development program designed specifically for law enforcement trainers. The program covers a variety of topics all focused on providing professional trainers with the necessary tools and techniques to enhance the learning and retention of skills and tactics for law enforcement professionals.

14. Field Training Officer 19-286 September 9-13 Sullivan Co. Sheriff's Office B. Dooley

This course is designed to prepare the law enforcement officer to become a training officer who will oversee the new recruit during his/her probationary period. The officer will learn how to evaluate and predict any problems during the recruit's training phase. (Specialized Law Enforcement ONLY)

15. Interview & Interrogation with Statement 19-738 Sept 16-18 Sullivan County SO Strickler

This course is designed to provide law enforcement officers the needed tools of information to conduct proper interviews and interrogations along with using Statement Analysis.

**16. Police Basic SWAT School 19-310 Sept 30-Oct 3 Kingsport K. Hite
Police Firing Range**

This course is design to prepare the officers with the skills and knowledge associated with Special Weapons and Tactics. (Specialized Law Enforcement only)

**17. Improvised Explosive Devices/Booby Traps 19-331 October 7-11 Knoxville J. Quick
220 Carrick St. TN**

This course is designed to educate law enforcement officers about the hazards of IED's and bobby traps that are commonly utilized against law enforcement officers and citizens. (Specialized Law Enforcement only). **(CSA included)**
